It is estimated that the number of native words in the English Dictionaries are only about 30%.


The English language is a mixture of tongues. It retains some traces of Celtic, but also contains some words from old German, Latin and old Norse. In addition, English also contains a lot of French words.

Modern English can be divided into four quarters:

- 1. Original English words, related to the Dutch.
- 2. Words of Latin origin.
- 3. Words of French origin.
- 4. Words from all other languages: Greek, Italian, Spanish, Maldivian, Russian, Hebrew, Japanese.

MAP REVEALS THE BEST LANGUAGES TO SPEAK

Speak and write English, and the world will hear you. Speak or write Tamil or Portuguese, and you may have a harder time getting your message out. Now, a new method for mapping how information flows around the globe identifies the best languages to spread your ideas far and wide.



In the networks, English has the most transmissions to and from other languages and is the most central hub.

Some Languages with large populations of speakers, such as Mandarin, Hindi and Arabic ,are relatively isolated in theses networks. This means that fewer communications in those languages reach speakers of other languages. Meanwhile, a language like Dutch spoken by 27 million people can be a disproportionately large conduit, compared with a language like Arabic, which has a whopping 530 million native and second -language speakers. This is because the Dutch are very multilingual and very online.

The network maps show what is already widely known. If you want to get your ideas out, you can reach a lot of people through the English language. These networks are revealed in detail at the study's website.

For non-English speakers, the choice of English as second or third language is an obvious one. For English speakers, the analysis suggests it would be more advantageous to choose Spanish over Chinese- at least if they're spending their ideas through writing.

- British colonialism began the spread of English around the world
- The English language has similarities with both French and German as its first forms were originally brought to Britain by German settlers, and later influenced by the Normans, who spoke a language closely related to French.
- Latin and Greek words have been added to the English language after the birth and spread of Christianity.
- In more than 100 countries, including China, Russia, GermanyAnd Egypt,English is the main foreign language taught at schools.
- One in six people in the world speak English.750 million of them do not come from an English speaking countries!
- The Oxford English Dictionary offers over 500 000 words.
 In addition ,it is estimated to be up to 500 000 technical and scientific terms that are not included in it.

- Half of scientific and technical journals in the world are published in English.
- 80% of all the information stored on computers worldwide is stored in the English medium.
- English is the main language used on the Internet .It is also the language that 75% of the word's mail and cables are made with.
